Azusa Theological Seminary (Azusa) serves as the official ministerial training school for the Verenigde Pinkster- en Evangeliegemeente (VPE), The Assemblies of God of The Netherlands. A four year Bachelor of Theology program is offered to students wishing to enter full or part-time ministry or to enhance their present ministerial skills. Graduates of the Seminary with a four year Bachelor of Theology may continue their studies with the Vrije Universiteit, Amsterdam (VU) at the Masters level and then the Doctoral level. Azusa shares the facilities of the Theological Faculty of the VU and has made agreements whereby Azusa graduates may pursue further VU degrees. The establishment of a Professorial Chair for Pentecostal Studies and of The Hollenweger Center for the Interdisciplinary Study of Pentecostal and Charismatic Movements form an integral part of these agreements.

Azusa is officially recognized by the Dutch government. No direct government subsidy is received by Azusa; however, full-time students are eligible for student grants under accepted Dutch regulations.

The approximate cost for one year of full-time study is about 2500 Euros, which includes books (the price can vary on this), tuition and fees. Housing costs are not included in this price. Housing information is available on our website.

The study load for a full-time student is normally about 16 hours per week of class time and about 24 hours per week of study time.

Azusa is in the process of determining target groups that would be interested in studying for the Bachelor of Theology in English. Because English is a dominant language of the world, many people groups will learn English as a second or third language. For some, the possibility of studying in English would be a welcome opportunity. One target group we have in mind is the migrant churches. For those that have better language skills in English rather than Dutch, a study program in English would give them the prospect of preparing for ministry or enhancing their ministry skills while living in The Netherlands.
